Classroom Items (Required)

***Language Arts/Writing**

- spiral bound notebook
- composition notebook
- highlighter
- post-it notes

***Math**

- composition notebook (with grid lines for graphing OR composition notebook and graphing paper)
- dry erase markers

***Reading**

- composition notebook

***Science**

- composition notebook
- additional materials may be requested as needed

***Social Studies**

- composition notebook or spiral bound notebook
- additional materials may be requested as needed

***General Supplies**

-1 inch binder (Leadership Notebook)

- designated mailbox folder (take home/return to school)
- notebook paper (wide-ruled) for all classes (will have to replenish as needed)
- pencil bag, NOT box (students name needs to be on this)
- pencils (#2 lead or mechanical)
- erasers (pencil top)
- glue sticks
- colored pencils/markers
- scissors
- tissues
- headphones/earbuds
- pack of dividers (5 or more)
- spray deodorant
- dry erase markers
- Ziploc bags (gallon and quart)
- hand sanitizer
- Clorox wipes

***Organizational Method (Required)**

Option 1-Three ring, hard cover 1" or 1.5" binder, with dividers labeled for each of the 5 core subjects (Language Arts/Writing, Math, Reading, Science, and Social Studies) (TEACHERS FAVORITE!)

Option 2-Accordion folder with pockets labeled for each of the 5 core subjects (Language Arts/Writing, Math, Reading, Science, and Social Studies)

Option 3-5 labeled, half inch (0.5") binder for each of the 5 core subjects (Language Arts/Writing, Math, Reading, Science, and Social Studies)

If your child has another idea for organization, please discuss that possibility with your child's homeroom teacher in advance. Please help your child get their supplies labeled and organized prior to the first day of school. Thank you!
