Job Descriptions:

- **Morning Greeter Leaders (2)**- Stand by entrance doors and welcome students, teachers, and parents into the building each morning. **GRADES K-6**
- **Photographer (1)**-Will photograph morning meetings, leadership luncheons and any other school events during the month. **GRADES 5-6**
- **Morning Hall Leaders(2)**-Direct traffic in the hallway and give out Good Dog tickets for those students following correct hallway procedures-**GRADES 4-6**
- **Morning Message Leader (1)**-Read an inspirational/motivational quote over the intercom Monday-Thursday morning of each week. **GRADES 4-6**
- **Morning Meeting Leaders (4)**-Assist with morning meetings on Fridays of each week. Students may be the emcee, lead the pledge, recognize birthdays, discuss the 7 Habits or whatever else is important for that week. **GRADES K-6**
- **Breakfast Table Leaders (2)**-Help to wipe down tables and assist students finding a place to sit each morning. **GRADES K-6**
- **Radio Runner Leaders (1)**- Take the radios from the office down to the gym each afternoon for a teacher to use on Car Rider Duty. **GRADES K-6**
- **Good Dog Leaders (1)**- Draw names for Good Dog, Leader of the Pack, and Big Dog Awards each Friday during assembly. **GRADES K-6**
- **Lost and Found Leaders (1)**-Take clothes, backpacks, etc. from gym floor and straighten Lost and Found Rack each morning. **GRADES 2-6**
- **Afternoon Announcement Leaders(1)**-Read the announcements on the school intercom system each afternoon **GRADES 3-6**
- **Grounds Crew Leaders(8)**-Work with Mr. Dallas to clean up trash around the playground and park area of the school each week. **GRADES 3-6**
- **Transportation Changes Leader(2)**-Take transportation change notes from the office to each classroom teacher in the building each afternoon. **GRADES 4-6**
- **Flag Leaders(2)**-Put up flag each morning and take down flag each afternoon **GRADES 4-6**
- **Lunchroom Clean-Up Leaders (4)**- Help Mr. Dallas sweep the cafeteria floor and store tables
- **Cone Leader (1)**- Put out and take up the cones each afternoon at dismissal in the gym. This leader must be a car rider daily. **GRADES K-6**
- **Library Leaders (2)**- Collect library books from homerooms each morning and deliver those to the library. **GRADES 3-6**
- **Ice Runner(1)**-Runs to the cafeteria to pick up ice for the health room 1 or 2 times per week **GRADES K-3**
- **Newsletter Distributors(2)**-Distributes newsletters to students on Fridays **GRADES 4-6**
