

Car Rider Information

For the safety of our students, every child who will be a car rider regularly during the school year will need to pick-up a Car Rider Card from the office. If there are two or more people who will regularly be picking the child up, you may need two cards. For families with more than one child attending Alvaton, all names may be placed on one card.

In order to pick up your child, you must have this card displayed on the driver's side dashboard. These will need to be visible throughout the entire school year. Students will be released from the car rider line only. There will be no "front door" pick up.

If there is an occasional day when a child will be picked up, the parent will need to send a note that is signed and dated that explains who will be picking up the child. If no note is sent, the person picking the child up will be directed to park and provide the office with identification to verify that his/her name appears on the child's emergency card.

If a child is going home with a friend, a signed and dated note must be sent to school, be stamped in the office and presented to teachers at car rider dismissal.

In the event of an emergency, please call school prior to 2:45 to let the office know of any pick-up arrangements that are necessary.
