

**Drakes Creek Middle School
SBDM Council Meeting Minutes
June 19, 2012**

Minutes of the Drakes Creek Middle School School Based Decision Making Council's meeting held Tuesday, June 19, 2012 in the conference room of Drakes Creek Middle School, located at 704 Cypress Wood Way, Bowling Green, Kentucky 42104.

CALL THE MEETING TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at 9:10 AM by Mr. Tom Renick, Interim Principal.

Members present were: Mr. Renick, interim principal; Tom Bromer, teacher representative; Melanie Gentry, teacher representative; Rosemary Irwin, teacher representative; Greg Witty, teacher representative; and Bryan Veatch, parent representative. Also present was Daryl Woods, 2012-2013 principal.

A motion was made by Mr. Veatch and seconded by Ms. Gentry to accept the agenda as presented. Motion passed.

Council Members were given a copy of the minutes from the May 24, 2012 meeting. A motion to approve the minutes as read was made by Mr. Witty and seconded by Ms. King. Motion passed.

OLD BUSINESS

There was no old business to report.

NEW BUSINESS

The 2012-2013 student handbook was presented to the council. A motion was made by Mr. Bromer and seconded by Ms. Irwin to accept the handbook as printed. Motion passed.

A motion was made by Ms. King and seconded by Mr. Witty to re-allocate 5 extended days from the assistant principal position to the student services coordinator. In addition, the council will use approximately \$1,500 of the budgeted personnel purchases account to purchase 5 additional days for the student services coordinator. These days, along with the 5 already allocated to the student services coordinator will total 15 extended days for the student services coordinator position. This recommendation will be sent to the school board for approval. Motion passed.

A motion was made by Ms. Gentry and seconded by Mr. Bromer to use approximately \$1,200 of the budgeted personnel purchases account to purchase 127 hours for a library assistant/cafeteria monitor position. Motion passed.

Pursuant to the provisions of KRS 61.810(1)(f), a motion was made by Ms. King and seconded by Ms. Irwin to go into closed session for discussion of personnel issues. Motion passed.

A motion to go back into open session was made by Ms. King and seconded by Mr. Witty.
Motion passed.

After consultation with the council, Mr. Renick recommended Ms. Ginger Travis for the Title 1
Math position.

A motion was made by Ms. Gentry and seconded by Mr. Veatch and seconded by Mr. Bromer.
Motion passed.
