Minutes of Drakes Creek Middle School's SBDM Council's meeting held Monday, October 27, 2014, in the library of Drakes Creek Middle School, located at 704 Cypress Wood Way, Bowling Green, Kentucky 42104.

CALL THE MEETING TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at 4:00 PM by Mr. Daryl Woods, principal.

Mr. Woods opened the meeting with the agenda for the current meeting. The agenda was approved by consensus.

BUDGETS

Presented the budgets for August and September 2014. School activity funds. New Red Book regulation that will govern activity funds. Activity Funds will be moved to Central Office accounts, out of Drakes Creek. As of right now, school activity funds cannot be used as operational expenses. Review of activity funds. Discussion about results. Achievement scores and Gap scores increased. Growth scores decreased slightly. College/Career Readiness increased slightly and Program Reviews received 100% of points possible.

Overall score 71.4; jumped from 78th percentile to 89th percentile in the State, meeting all our objectives for the school year.

Woods and Ms. Perkins will look at the data to complete CSIP.

EXPLORE Data Review:

Our scores dropped, which is consistent across the state. DCMS is above national norms, except for math.

CSIP Committee:

Asking for volunteers for CSIP committee. Woods and Perkins will lead the committee, a couple of teachers have signed up and asking for parent volunteers.
