

**Drakes Creek Middle School
SBDM Council Meeting Minutes
November 24, 2014**

Minutes of Drakes Creek Middle School's SBDM Council's meeting held Monday, November 24, 2014, in the library of Drakes Creek Middle School, located at 704 Cypress Wood Way, Bowling Green, Kentucky 42104.

CALL THE MEETING TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at 4:00 PM by Mr. Daryl Woods, principal.

The agenda approved by consensus.

BUDGETS

Presented the Budget Report. Again, mentioned that School Activity Funds will be moving to the Fund 21 account at Central Office.

The choir club bought a new piano for \$5,600. This piano replaced the 27-year old piano that had been in the school since it opened..

The KYA account was up to \$12,000, but wrote a check for the KYA conference.

We raised \$1,900 from the auction baskets for PBIS. The book fair made \$4,000.

The Site Based Budget. Anything SC6X is under SBDM control.

Alvey asked if the Cross Country and Track team expenses were paid from Greenwood or Drakes Creek. Woods responded that DCMS pays for the coaches.

Livchek asked if we pay for uniforms. Woods said that we can contribute to the uniforms, but most of it comes from the activity accounts.

This is our final SBDM Allocation for the year. We were allocated funds based on a student population 596 at 95% attendance. Our attendance is much better, we have 611 student with 97% attendance. Our allocations changed from \$56,614.04 to \$59,293. We had a balance forward of \$14,047.80. We were awarded \$1,000 for administrative travel and \$8,000 for student travel. The only difference between original and current allocation is the amount for extended days.

We have \$19,115 placed in the contingency category for more flexibility.

Budgets approved by consensus.

OLD BUSINESS

Previous meetings minutes were submitted and approved by consensus.

CSIP Committee has formed and will meet on Monday, December 8. SBDM must approve the CSIP plan. We will need to approved the CSIP plan at our next meeting on 12/15.
