NEW BUSINESS

Results of our Site Based Council Elections - Laura Jacobs

6th Grade Transition: Mr. Woods will attend a planning meeting on October 15. This year's Site Based Council may not be very involved in the 6th grade transition, but next year's Council will be very involved.

Architect plans: We are losing parking lots; the diesel tanks will be removed and parking will be relocated. We are getting 15 new classrooms, 2 multipurpose rooms which can be used as locker rooms with a moveable wall; 2 science classrooms; 1 administration office in the new wing. The other addition is that our current cafeteria will be expanded to hold a whole grade level. We are going to add bleachers at each end of the gym. Spectators will not be allowed to sit on those end bleachers during games. The District is expecting us to open with 1000 students when the 6th graders come in. We have asked them to move the door of the auxiliary gym to the side where is easier to monitor students coming in. Building will begin March 1, 2016, if we expect to be finished in time. Woods is asking for suggestions for any other needs in the new building.
