

Dismissal Procedures

Goal: The Natcher Elementary afternoon dismissal will be a time when students walk to their destinations in a quiet, safe, orderly manner.

STUDENTS:

Bus

1. Students will listen to afternoon announcements with a level zero voice.
2. Students stay in homeroom until their bus # is called.
3. When the students bus # is called, they will walk down the each side of the hallway on the second tile (walking on the paws).
4. Students will walk with the supervising teacher at a level 0.

Afterschool Program

1. Students will be dismissed to the cafeteria when called.
3. When students are dismissed, they will walk down the right side of the hallway on the second tile.
2. Students will walk to the cafeteria at a level 0.

Walkers

1. Students will be dismissed to the foyer when called.
2. When the students are dismissed, they will walk down the right side of the hallway on the second tile (walking on the paws).
3. Students will walk at a level 0 while in the building.

Car Riders

1. When the students are dismissed, they will walk down the right side of the hallway on the second tile (paws) to the gym.
2. Students will walk at a level 0.
3. Once in the gym, students will sit in assigned rows based on grade level and listen for their name to be called.
4. Once a student hears his or her name called, he or she will exit the gym and line up outside at numbered cones.

TEACHERS/ADULTS:

1. Homeroom teachers will remain in classrooms until all students are dismissed. (Teachers who have morning bus duty will stay if there is a late bus.)
2. Supervising teachers will meet students in hall and walk them to the designated areas.
