

## **HALLWAY PROCEDURES**

### Goal for Hallway Procedures

Students will walk to and from classes in a quiet and orderly manner.

### Students:

1. Students stand or walk on the second tile on the right side of the hallway.
2. Each student should face forward.
3. Hands will be to his or herself at all times. Teams may decide how. For example: ducktails and bubbles, behind back, to the side, etc. Items should be carried with both hands in front of you.
4. Level 0 (Silence) in hallway.
5. Walk in the hall.
6. Backpacks should be worn on backs. Backpacks on wheels are pulled at the students' sides.

### Teachers/Adults:

1. Teachers will position themselves to most efficiently supervise students as they move through the halls.
2. Teachers are to use soft voices for professional conversations while in the hallways so that other classes are not disturbed.
3. Teachers should instruct student leader to stop at all designated door facings or intersections to allow students to catch up before moving.
