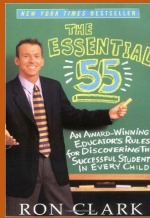
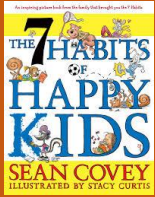

## 7 Habits & Essential 55



This week we will put a special focus on Habit 2: Begin With the End in Mind. Have a plan. Plan ahead and set goals (personal and school related). A goal not written is only a wish.

We will focus this week on the following Essential 55 Rule by Ron Clark ~ Rule 23: Quickly learn the name of other teachers in the school and greet them by saying things like, "Good morning Mrs. Graham," or "Good afternoon Ms. Ortiz. That is a very pretty dress." (Note: If you are in line with the rest of class, you are not allowed to speak to the teachers at that time because the no-talking rule is in effect. You should speak to other teachers if you are entering or leaving the school, on recess, on an errand, or changing classes.)

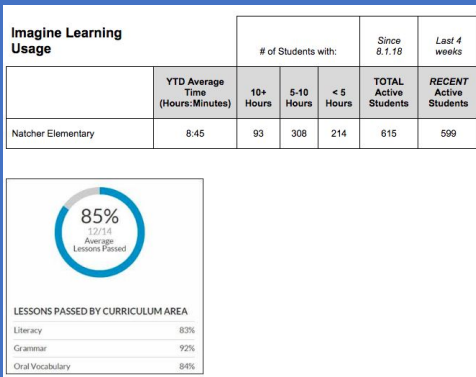
