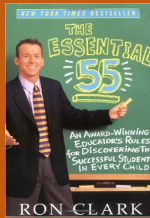
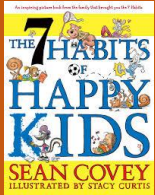

Hello Natcher Elementary Families!

Natcher's FCA group is gearing up for another great year! This year, Natcher's FCA meetings will be **Every Friday Morning, 8:00 – 8:15 AM, in the Music Room**. Our first meeting of the year will be on **Friday, October 12, 2018**. FCA meetings will consist of great Christian speakers that have been involved at many levels of athletics, fun activities, crafts, games, and Bible devotionals! This is a 100% student-led group and is open to any child in grades 3-6. Your child does not need to be involved in athletic sports to join this group – anyone is welcome! Parents are welcome anytime as well. If you have a child in grades 3-6 and also have younger children at Natcher, the siblings are welcome to join the meetings also if you feel it is appropriate for them.

FCA is a non-denominational Christian organization that was founded in 1954 and seeks to instill Godly values in young people through short Bible lessons, character building, and encouragement from many different recommended speakers by the local FCA organization. As the largest Christian Sports Ministry in America, FCA focuses on serving local communities by providing a positive peer group and holding up Christ-like role models to students.

FCA is free, but since it is a Christian organization, **a parent needs to sign this permission form and return it to the office** for your child to be allowed to attend FCA. Meetings will be *every Friday morning at 8:00 AM that school is in session*, and you can just drop your child off at the front entrance. (Or come in and join us!) If students eat breakfast at school, *they may get breakfast from the cafeteria and bring it to the Music Room*. Meetings will end in plenty of time for students to get to class – no instructional time will be missed!

We are also looking for students (and families) who would be interested in leading our FCA meetings by giving a testimony, short devotion, or Christian-centered craft/activity. If your child is interested in being a student leader, and/or you would be willing to help your child lead a meeting this year, please check "YES" below or email us!
