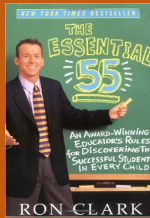
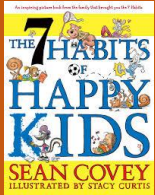

7 Habits & Essential 55



This week we will put a special focus on Habit 5: “Seek First to Understand, Then to be Understood.” Listen before you talk.

We will focus this week on the following Essential 55 Rule by Ron Clark ~ Rule 14: “Answer all questions with a complete sentence. For example, if the question asks, “What is the capital of Russia?” you should respond by writing, “The capital of Russia is Moscow.” Also, in conversation with others, it is important to use complete sentences out of respect for the person’s question. For example, if a person asks, “How are you?” instead of just responding by saying, “Fine,” you should say, “I’m doing fine, thank you. How about yourself?”
