

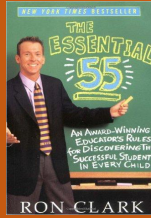
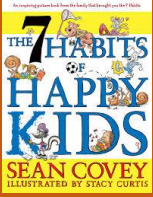

The National Archery in the Schools Program (NASP) was launched in 2001 with the goal of having an archery program in every school in the state of Kentucky. You can learn more about the history of this organization at: www.naspschools.org

Natcher Elementary formed its first archery team in 2016-17 and participated in two tournaments. We have now competed in more tournaments and made it to the State Tournament. We have an opportunity to lay the foundation as these students go to Middle School and High School to compete at higher levels.

The archery fee (per archer) is \$20 due on or before October 10, 2018. We are able to raise some funds through donations, Spirit Nights, and through our fundraiser "Penny Wars" to supply all the equipment necessary.

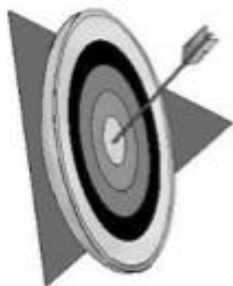
