**Regularly Scheduled Meeting Minutes
WEHS Library**

1. The meeting was called to order at 3:30pm by Mr. Vincent.
2. Mr. Stuckey, Mr. Brooks, Ms. Croney, and Mrs. Garner were present. Mrs. Dickey and Mrs. Harrell were absent.
3. The meeting agenda was approved by consensus after a first motion by Mrs. Garner and a second by Mr. Brooks.
4. The minutes from the September 21, 2020 Regularly Scheduled Meeting were approved by consensus after a first motion by Mr. Stuckey and a second by Ms. Croney.
5. Mr. Vincent wished Ms. Croney a happy birthday. Mr. Vincent also mentioned that Friday, October 23rd, is Ken Skea Day. He also stated that Calendar Girl went well and that so far this year we have had senior nights for our fall sports as a really positive meeting with the Chamber of Commerce and MedCenter Health.

Mr. Vaughn shared that he and Mr. Vincent met with MedCenter Health and the Bowling Green Chamber of Commerce on Monday, October 19, to discuss the new WEHS Medical Arts program and its future as well as partnership and support options. Mr. Vincent shared that the Chamber and MedCenter Health were both excited and fully onboard with the school's goal.
